Current situation:

This risk assessment sets out the potential hazards that may spread infection with COVID-19 and the risk of that occurring. It then seeks to identify suitable control measures that will reduce that risk to as low a level as reasonably practicable.

From 19 July 2021 under step 4 of the Governments COVID 19 roadmap most coronavirus restrictions were removed in England. The Government is no longer instructing people to work from home if they can. The Government has recommended a gradual return to workplaces over the summer. We have updated our risk assessments and control measures to include the Governments latest recommendations for safety measures within offices to ensure that all personnel who may enter the organisation's site or are affected by their processes are, as far as reasonably practicable, protected.

This risk assessment should be read in conjunction with the firms guide to the COVID-19 control measures that have been adopted, as it sets out the personal responsibilities of all staff.

The requirements to protect from COVID-19 do not at any time replace or outweigh the need to comply with normal Health and Safety regulations.
